PC-DMIS Copyright and License Information

PC-DMIS software is protected by United States and International copyrights. PC-DMIS software is developed by Wilcox Associates, Inc., a Hexagon Metrology company, and is sold worldwide by Hexagon Metrology, its subsidiaries and authorized distributors.

PC-DMIS software is licensed, not sold. Use of PC-DMIS requires you to accept the terms of the [end-user license agreement \(EULA\)](#). Is your copy of PC-DMIS Legal?

There are various reasons why you might have a non-legal copy of PC-DMIS, especially if you are not the original owner of the equipment. They are outlined below:

Used Equipment

The PC-DMIS license agreement only allows for "pass-along" transfers of the license to a party other than the original purchaser under limited, specific circumstances, which are outlined in the license agreement. Generally, PC-DMIS licenses obtained with equipment purchased at auction, through a used equipment broker/dealer or another third party are not valid under the End User License Agreement. The License requires any copies of PC-DMIS obtained in this way to be specifically accepted by the current owner and have all Software Maintenance Agreement (SMA) fees paid and current for the license to be valid.

Purchasers of used equipment should use great caution when purchasing the machine to ensure that the PC-DMIS license is transferable and valid before the purchase. In addition, purchasers should be careful that the transferred license dongle (described below) actually belongs to that machine. Often a purchaser discovers that a broker or auctioneer sold a machine with a PC-DMIS dongle that is not configured for the machine sold, and as a result PC-DMIS cannot be used.

If you have a copy of PC-DMIS that you obtained with a used machine, you can check the validity of your license, or request a license transfer, (with a valid SMA or the purchase of an SMA) by calling Customer Relations 855.4.HEXMET or use the online form.

Benefits of an SMA

- Access to technical support by phone and email
- Access to version upgrades during the SMA period
- Knowledge that your PC-DMIS license has been legally transferred and is valid.

Other Situations

PC-DMIS requires use of a hardware key to operate, sometimes called a "dongle" or "hasp".



PC-DMIS LICENSE

This key attaches to a USB or serial port. If your copy of PC-DMIS does not require the use of a key, the software is probably not legal.

If you purchased your copy of PC-DMIS from someone other than Hexagon Metrology or one of our authorized distributors, the software is probably not legal.

If you are using a "cloned" hardware key purchased from a third party, your software is not legal.

The following is the full text of the PC-DMIS end-user license agreement that all users who install or use PC-DMIS software are required to accept.

PC-DMIS END-USER SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS BEFORE INSTALLING AND/OR USING THIS WILCOX ASSOCIATES, INC. SOFTWARE PRODUCT. THE SOFTWARE LICENSE IS A LEGAL AGREEMENT, WITH IMPORTANT LEGAL CONSEQUENCES, BETWEEN YOU, THE LICENSEE (EITHER AN INDIVIDUAL OR A SINGLE ENTITY), AND THE LICENSOR, WILCOX ASSOCIATES, INC., REGARDING THE ACCOMPANYING SOFTWARE. THIS AGREEMENT IS PRESENTED FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL AS A MANDATORY STEP IN THE INSTALLATION OF THE SOFTWARE. INSTALLING THE SOFTWARE ON YOUR COMPUTER SIGNIFIES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF AND AGREEMENT TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The term "the Software" means the PC-DMIS software accompanying this license, including all of the files supplied on the product medium and all copies, modified or otherwise, derived from them, and any parts thereof. The term "licensed copy" or "licensed copies" refers to the number of copies for which Licensor has been paid for a license.

LICENSE

This license governs all releases, revisions or enhancements of the Software. The Licensee may operate each licensed copy of the Software on one personal computer, and may copy the

Software to one additional personal computer solely for backup purposes. The Licensee may use the Software on a network, provided that the user has licensed a copy of the Software for each computer that can access the Software over that network.

The Licensee acknowledges and agrees that title and all rights of ownership to the Software are and remain with Licensor. No title to or ownership rights in the Software shall pass to the Licensee or any user in any circumstances.

TRANSFER

The Software may be transferred to another party as part of a machine sale that includes the Software license, provided that (i) the transferring user does not retain any copies thereof; (ii) as a condition precedent to the effectiveness of any such transfer, the receiving party must expressly accept the terms and conditions of this license in writing via written notification to Wilcox Associates, Inc.; and (iii) the transferred license must be current in Software Maintenance at the time of transfer .

TERM

This license is effective until terminated, and terminates automatically as described in this agreement. This license can be terminated by the Licensee at any time by destroying all copies ñ whole, portions or merged ñ of the Software. It is also terminated if any portion of this agreement is violated by the Licensee. Licensee agrees to destroy all copiesówhole, portions, or mergedóof the Software when the license terminates.

IF THE USER TRANSFERS POSSESSION OF THE SOFTWARE OR ANY COPY OF THE SOFTWARE TO ANOTHER PARTY, EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED IN THIS LICENSE, THIS LICENSE IS AUTOMATICALLY TERMINATED.

General.
